Registration

- APPLY FOR ADMISSION** to City or Mesa or Miramar College at **CCCApply** (Only 1 app needed for all 3 colleges).
APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID (<https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid>) or the California Dream Act application at: dream.csac.ca.gov
- REQUEST TRANSCRIPTS** from prior Institutions.
- Complete ORIENTATION**, verify **ASSESSMENT (MILESTONES)**, and **meet with a COUNSELOR** for an **EDUCATION PLAN**.
- Log into mySDCCD**, view classes and **place classes into your shopping cart**. Complete the 3 step enrollment process **on or after your assigned Registration Date & Time**. (If waitlisted, monitor your status and/or email your instructor and request a **PERMISSION NUMBER** at the start of class.)
- PAY YOUR FEES** and/or **CONFIRM your Aid has covered all fees: Students may be DROPPED from classes for non-payment of fees.** (\$46 per unit, \$20 student health fee (\$17 for Summer term), **NON-RESIDENT** students will also pay \$304 per unit, and **BACCALAUREATE** courses are charged an additional \$84 per upper division unit.)

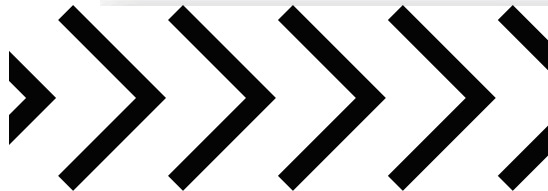
